Finally, I'm settling in Pittsburgh. I have to admit that, it's been very hard to be back. After 4 months of living in my country (Peru), and be with my family and friends, it took me a while to get used to being back.

However, now, I'm so happy to be back in YWAM Pittsburgh, doing what God has called me to do in the first place.

My time in Peru was amazing!. Not only because I had the chance to be with my family, but also because of the ministry opportunities that I had.

In December, I organized a Christmas party for the kids in Huaycan (a very poor city in Lima). With the help and support of my home churches in Lima and Pittsburgh, we brought happiness to 132 kids.

We gave them a bag full of presents and school supplies .We fed them and showed God's love to them. They were so happy. We had an awesome time!



In January and February, I helped organize our 17 day summer missionary program called **Joshua Generation (JG)**

We had 46 Peruvian kids (15-21 years old) who were part of JG. They were incredible and so hungry and passionate for God! They witnessed to more than 5,000 people and 4,992 people were saved. **Praise the Lord!**



By the end of February and the very beginning of March, I stayed back with a small team helping the churches that we worked with to follow up on the new believers.

We called and visited all the new believers and as a result of that, the new believers were connected with the churches. Some of the churches started new services due to the increase of their visitors.

Overall, my 4 months back at home were very exciting and fruitful, surrounded by the company of my family and friends. Thank you so much for being part of my ministry in these last 4 months!



## WHAT'S NEXT?

Right now, I'm part of the team in charge of the organization of Joshua Generation in the States.

This summer, for the first time, we are planning to have 80 students. 40 American kids, 20 African-American, and 20 international kids.

God has spoken to us to start doing things differently, to start thinking outside of the box. Just because the way we did some stuff worked 5 years ago, it doesn't mean that we need to keep doing it the same way.

We are so excited for this new challenge, getting ready for this new adventure.

We are going to have 2 JGs. One is from June 19th– July 6th and the other one is from July 10th—July 29th.

For the first one, we are planning to have the boot camp phase in Pittsburgh and go to Baltimore to do evangelism (outreach phase).

For the second one, we will have the boot camp phase in Singapore and the outreach phase in Hong Kong, Taiwan and China.



This year, YWAM's focus is to fill Asia with God's glory. Our goal is to send teams from all over the world to the whole continent of Asia through out this year.

To do that, we are having a Missionary Conference (**GO FEST ASIA**) in Singapore from July 16th to July 19th. We are going to be focusing on Asia's need for God and God's heart for them.
