This past 3 months I've been so busy working with our **DTS-Discipleship Training School** (a YWAM school dedicated to train people into the mission field) and with our summer missionary camp **Joshua Generation**.

On December 11th we went to Brazil for 3 weeks. Our team was a group of 12 people who were part of the School. We did street evangelism using dances and dramas; we visited several orphanages, and shared in different churches and youth groups. We had an awesome time there! We had the opportunity to pray for lot of people and encourage the Brazilians to go to the mission field.

In those 3 weeks that we ministered in the city of Rio de Janeiro and Sao Paulo, we saw around 900 people giving their life to Jesus and 2 miracle healings. To God is the glory!

After those weeks, we flew to Lima, Peru to continue doing outreaches. I was in charge of setting up the places to minister and the churches that we worked with. We worked with my home church in Lima for 5 days. For me, it was a privilege to work with them and bring my team to my own country and my community to preach the gospel. We saw God's hand moving among the people of Lima.

Preaching in JG

From January 17th till February 8th we had our missionary summer camp called Joshua Generation. This year we had 51 kids from different churches of Lima. God surprised us with lot of people. We had people from Colombia, Brazil, India, Canada and United States who joined with us to be part of JG.

We had an amazing 18 days where the kids learned to know God and to make him known. We divided in 3 teams. Each team ministered in specific ways all over Lima. One team used Christian reggeton concerts, dances and drama to share the gospel. The other team ministered to kids doing VBS and kid clubs. And the last team preached using the sports. They did soccer clinics and sports camps. They used that as a way to attract people, get to know them and then preach them.

As a result of that, 4092 people prayed with us to accept Jesus in their heart. Also, we had 7 healings. God used 51 kids to rock Lima upside down!

Also, during that time, we challenged the kids to go overseas to preach the gospel. This has been our 4th time doing JG in Peru. So,

we felt that this year we needed to take a step forward. So, we decided to take some of the kids to Colombia to preach the gospel. We challenged them to believe in God and increase their faith.

We are planning to go to Colombia on March 7th till the 17th. We need to raise \$500 each one. So I ask you for your prayers so they will be able to raise the money. During this time, I'm going to be organizing the Colombia trip and encouraging the kids to go.
