First of all thank you so much for supporting me from the very beginning of my ministry. You and Debby are a huge blessing for me, enabling me to do what God has called me to do.

I am planning to renew my commitment with YWAM, Pittsburgh at least for one year more. Because, even though we are planning on starting the base in Lima, for our first year we are going to be under YWAM Pittsburgh, because they are the ones who will send us there.

I am definitely going to need support. Starting a base is exciting, but at the same time scary. We are going to start from zero. We haven't anything there, no property, office, place to live, computers, etc, etc. And we are the ones who have to take care of all that stuff. So far, it is just 4 of us going. We are stepping out on Faith, believing in God's provision and doing what he asks to do.

After the summer ends, by the end of August, the 4 of us are going to be release from working at the base, to start focusing more in fund raising for YWAM Lima. We are still going to be part of YWAM Pittsburgh, but we are going to be working on getting stuff ready for our departure. Actually I'm thinking on having a fund raising trip in September and I was thinking of going to Chicago first. I would love to talk with the missions committee and have a presentation about what I'm going to be doing and explain better our vision for YWAM Lima.

To start the base everyone of us needs to raise a monthly support of \$2,000 and that will cover the rent of an apartment there, getting an office to start working, food, transportation, laptop, money for emergency, ministry expenses, etc.

The desire of my heart is to see that happen. I want to see young Peruvians fulfilling the Great Commission. I want them to dream God's dream for them and actually doing it. So, starting a YWAM Base is the very beginning, and a dream coming true for me. But I have to be honest, it scares me a little bit, because I don't know what is going to happen. I don't know exactly how to get there. But I trust the Lord, and I will step out in Faith.

This is just a small overview about what I feel God is calling me to do. The passion that is burning in my heart and the vision that God is giving me. You know, Don, I want to be in ministry for the rest of my life. I want to serve God with my youth, but above else, I gave him my life. I don't know if that means to stay in YWAM or move to another country. I don't know now. I just know that I am open and willing to obey and just go, where ever he wants me to go.
