Praise God for how He has worked and is working in the following ministry opportunities:

- Dick co-facilitated a Sharpening Your Interpersonal Skills Workshop in March at TEAM mission headquarters for staff and Moody students.
- He has an increasingly active role as mission's coach for the next generation of missionaries as he works alongside Dave Childers, the WorldVenture director of the central region of the US.
