We look forward to the winter/spring semester and the opportunities to teach, disciple and equip for church planting. to make some more ministry trips to Wisconsin and to Florida, and I will be heading to Thailand once again. The Lord continues to expand our windows of opportunity and influence and we wish to trust him with wisdom to know how to get involved and to what extent.

Holly's investment in the Missionary Kid Care and Education department continues to grow and judging by some of the responses from parents and their college age children, it is paying off. She is presently working with some other Canadian mission organizations to plan an MK re-entry conference. MK's face unique challenges as they return to their sending countries and as a mission organization, we desire to facilitate some education and help to both parents and their adult children to provide a smooth transition.
