In late May we mentioned that we would be going out to some of the villages to train folks how to make good use of the MegaVoice players. Several of you expressed interest in knowing how things went. So here go 3 pictures (worth 30,000 words) and tidbits about the MegaVoice and how it has been received. First off let me say that things have gone more slowly than we had hoped. The Lord gave us good traveling weather in answer to prayer, but that same nice weather meant that many folks were out planting corn and could not come for the training sessions.

In Xubojasun (shoo-boh-ah-soon) 5 out of the 6 buyers were ladies from the church.

One player was bought by a young man who said he wanted it to play to his parents so they would come to a knowledge of the way of salvation.

A pastor told of how he had used a player with only "God's Story" on it to open a conversation with a woman who was praying at her heathen altar. She invited him into the house, and one member of the family accepted the Lord.

2 men told us how older folks had reacted to the creation story from Genesis. The Indian groups here worship the sun, and they have a hard time accepting that Someone made the sun. But these folks eventually accepted this, and indicated that it would force them to change some of their ideas and practices.

Several members of the Chuj Literature Committee were with us preparing themselves to take over the responsibility for doing training out in the villages, and have in fact started to get into it already. They were eager to train people in other religious groups, as a means of getting them listening to God's Word.

We are including 3 pictures. Since differences in margins do funny things to where pictures show up in e-mail, I will tell you what they are and you can easily fit the description to the picture.
