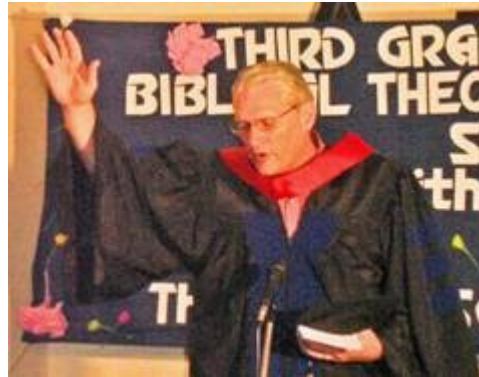
On Friday the big day arrived! Boi the happy bridegroom!
