### BOUND TOGETHER BY FRIENDSHIP

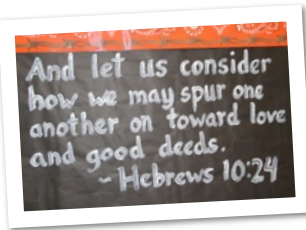
